

**ADVANCED VOICE RECOGNITION SYSTEMS, INC. UPDATES INTERFERENCE PROCEEDINGS BETWEEN AVRS, INC (SENIOR PARTY) AND ALLVOICE DEVELOPMENTS LTD (JUNIOR PARTY) AND THE LITIGATION BETWEEN ALLVOICE DEVELOPMENTS LTD. AND MICROSOFT CORP.**

(AVRS) OTCBB AVOI [www.avrsys.com](http://www.avrsys.com) today announced that Charles Gholz and the team at Oblon Spivak, in conjunction with the inventors and AVRS'S expert witness, have entered into the final round of filings in the proceedings in the interference between AVRS, Inc. (Senior party) and Allvoice (Junior party) that was declared March 9, 2010 involving Allvoice's patent No. 5,799,273 ("the Mitchell patent").

The Mitchell patent is also the subject of a patent infringement suit that Allvoice filed against Microsoft in August 2009 in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas. In that suit, Microsoft filed a motion for Partial Summary Judgment of Invalidity on October 12, 2010 under 35 U.S.C. 101 and 112 of all of Allvoice's claims involved in the interference.

President and CEO Walter Geldenhuys said, "I am pleased with the outcome to this point. AVRS has reached the final stage of the interference proceeding, and we are optimistic about achieving our objectives. We are planning for additional activities involving technology licensing initiatives, and we look forward to continued progress in advancing the recognition of our technology."
